Raj C. Dedhia, MD, MSCR is currently Associate Professor and Director of Sleep Surgery & CPAP Alternatives Clinic at the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia, PA USA.

Dr. Dedhia is board-certified in both sleep medicine and otolaryngology. He also serves as Co-Director of the Penn Sleep Medicine & Surgery fellowship, training 1-2 sleep otolaryngologists per year. He is also the 2017 recipient of the AASM Foundation's American Board of Sleep Medicine Junior Faculty Grant for his project titled, Hypoglossal Nerve Stimulation on Vascular Function in Patients with Obstructive Sleep Apnea. The goal of this project was to understand the effect of hypoglossal nerve stimulation on intermediate markers of cardiovascular risk.
