This grand round lecture will feature Dr. Benjamin Pliska and oral appliance treatment of obstructive sleep apnea (OSA). Topics will include:

- Assessing the effectiveness of morning mandibular repositioning splint use on minimizing the occlusal changes associated with mandibular advancing Oral Appliance treatment of OSA
- Determining the effects of periodontal disease, treatment adherence, and magnitude of mandibular advancement on occlusal changes associated with mandibular advancing Oral Appliance treatment of OSA
